Participants' reports will be presented **remotely (online)** at breakout sessions from April 4th, 2022.

The main goals and objectives of the conference:

MATERIALS SHOULD BE FOLLOWED IN THE FOLLOWING WAY:

- The volume of the thesis – no more than 1 page (the same for students, undergraduates, and doctoral students);
- Theses are accepted strictly without specifying a list of sources used, citation is allowed in the text. For example, (Ivanov, 2019);
- Page parameters: top margin - 2 cm, bottom margin - 2 cm, left - 3 cm, right - 1.5 cm;
- Font Times New Roman, KZ Times New Roman; font size – 12 pt;
- Line spacing - single; paragraph indentation - 1 cm; portrait orientation; headers and footers and page setting; the text is justified.

In addition to the materials, the file should also contain information about the authors (application for participation). The abstract file is called author.doc, where the author is the name of the student who will come to the conference, written in **Latin letters**, for example, Ivanov.doc. Abstracts must be saved in Microsoft Word format.

ORDER OF STRUCTURE OF THE ARTICLE:

On the next line is the center of the report in **CAPITAL LETTERS (in bold)**. There is no dot at the end of the name.

The names of the authors are placed at one interval under the title of abstracts, in the center relative to the main text, and are printed in Times New Roman 11 pt. Font.

The names of the leaders are located in the center relative to the main text and are printed in Times New Roman 11pt. Fonts. In the list of authors, the surname is first indicated then the initials of the author.

On the next line, in the center relative to the main text, indicate the institution, below the e-mail address of the author. The name of the institution and the e-mail address of the author are printed in italic Times New Roman 11 pt.

One interval (blank line) after the indentation is directly the material of the article.

The organizing committee of the conference reserves the right to reject reports submitted outside the main areas of the conference that do not meet the above requirements. The organizing committee does not suggest editing the text of publications. The author is responsible for the thesis submitted.

One author has the right to publish no more than 2 theses.

(!) Text abstract: no more than 500 words (avoid illustrations).

Materials received by the Organizing Committee are published in the conference proceedings.
