FACILITIES AVAILABLE IN THE UNIVERSITY

U.A. ZHOLDASBEKOV PALACE OF STUDENTS



The U.A. Zholdasbekov Palace of Students is a student center located in Almaty. The main aim of the palace is to meet the diverse cultural needs, and the development of amateur art of the students and youth by providing various services and facilities for students including recreational activities and cultural events. The palace also has a theater, a cinema, and a concert hall where students can attend performances and events. Al-Farabi Library



The library holds a vast collection of books, journals, and other research materials in various languages including Kazakh, Russian, English, and other languages. The library also has a digital collection of e-books and electronic journals that can be accessed by students and faculty members. The library also offers various services

such as interlibrary loans, document delivery, and reference assistance. The library is open to students, faculty, and researchers and has extended hours during exams and other busy periods.

Students Service Center “Keremet”



Students Service Center “Keremet” – is a youth recourse center for students that provides educational, medical, legal, financial and entertaining services on a one-window basis.

It plays a key role in helping students adjust to university life and succeed academically by providing various services such as academic advising, housing, financial aid, counseling, and extracurricular activities.

Students house



KazNU, being a university city, houses over 5,000 students in 14 modern and comfortable hostels, spanning a total area of 81,000 square meters. Each hostel offers a warm and welcoming atmosphere for students to call home.

House of Young Scientists



The House of Young Scientists, located on the university campus, is a residential complex designed for doctoral and undergraduate students. It offers amenities such as toilets, showers, new furniture, equipped kitchens, laundry rooms, a health center, a gym, dance halls, a modern telecommunications network, and Wi-Fi. Additionally, it boasts a convenient location, playground, and parking.



Catering Halls

The Catering hall, intended for students and faculty of the university, is situated on the territory of the student's city. In addition to the traditional cuisine, the catering hall also offers a variety of international dishes to cater to the diverse student population.

Student medical center



The hall operates on a self-service basis, and there are options for both buffet-style and sit-down meals. The prices are reasonable and affordable for students, making it a convenient option for those living on campus. The cleanliness and hygiene of the hall are also maintained at a high standard to ensure the health and well-being of the students

Al-Farabi University provides a range of services to students, including preventive vaccinations, monitoring of students who have been in contact with infectious patients, outpatient appointments, injury prevention, and preparatory arrangements for preventive medical examinations. The center also offers a range of medical experts, including dentists, psychologists, gynecologists, and therapists, and provides emergency medical assistance to students.

The center is open from 9:00 am to 6:00 pm, Monday through Friday, and is free of charge for Al-Farabi University students.

PRE-DEPARTURE CHECKLIST

The following list of items may be useful as you prepare and pack for your trip to Kazakhstan. Be sure to consider the weather and bring appropriate clothing and accessories.

Note! *It will probably be very cold if you arrive in winter. So make sure to keep a jacket, thermal/inner, shoes with thick soles, gloves and an umbrella handy.*

Once you get your invitation letter from the university, visa and have booked your flight. Inform your Advisor about your flight details. Get your documents.

1. Passport + Visa
2. Vaccination certificate/card
3. Admission letter received from the university
4. Copies of your passport-size photos.
5. Copy of your flight ticket.
6. High school Diploma (with Apostille)
7. National Entrance Examination Scorecard (if required)
8. Any National ID Proof
9. Visa International Debit-Card
10. Currency (Dollars/Euros/Tenge) for Food, Hostel & Yearly Fees.
11. Essentials like chargers and adapters, toiletries, medications, etc. Download “Yandex” and “2GIS” applications on your device.

Pre-arrange accommodation in Almaty



Arrange pick up from the Airport.

When you arrive in Almaty, it is likely that you will have luggage with you. To make your transportation to your place of stay more convenient, we recommend taking a taxi, which can be booked using the Yandex application. Additionally, it is a good idea to have some cash on hand, about 20,000 tenges, to cover expenses during your first few days in the city. If you don't have this amount, you should at least have around 5000 tenges for the taxi fare, and you can exchange your currency for more later, once you are settled in.

1. IIN (INDIVIDUAL IDENTIFICATION NUMBER)



IIN (Individual Identification Number) is a number that is unique and consists of 12 digits. If you are a foreign student in Kazakhstan, you will need to obtain an Individual Identification Number (IIN) in order to access certain services such as opening a bank account or obtaining a SIM card for a mobile phone.

Documents required-

Copy of your passport Copy of your visa Migration Card

Proof of your address in Kazakhstan Eg - rental agreement, utility bill, etc.

The process and required documents may vary depending on the local authorities. Submit the application for an IIN along with the above-mentioned documents.

After your application is processed, you will receive a letter with your IIN.

Note - You might need a translator/ local person to help you with the process as all the documents are in Russian and Kazakh.

2. 2 gis



For easy navigation in Kazakhstan, this app is a must-have tool for city residents. Downloading the offline map of Almaty on the app can be extremely helpful. Get quick access to various locations including restaurants, hospitals, and banks.

Note - If you don't know Russian/ Kazakh, you may need to translate the information on the app using Google Translate.

3. Onay



The best and cheapest way to travel in Almaty is by bus. The bus services start early morning and are available till 10 pm. This bus card can also be used as a metro card.

1. If you don't have a bus card you have to pay 150 tenges to the driver to get a ticket.

2. If you are a student under the age of 23, you can get a student bus card. This card will cost you only 40 tenges per ride.

You can keep recharging your bus card with the help of the Kaspi app.

How to apply for a student onay card?

Get a document from your respective faculty signed by the dean which basically states that you're a student of KazNU.

Take documents such as your passport, IIN, passport-size photograph, document and a minimum of 500 tenge cash or in Kaspi.

(Address to the onay office near the KazNU campus is mentioned in the locations section of the guidebook.)

3. If your age is above 23, you can get an adult bus card which will charge you around 80 tenge/ride.

Apart from this, you can also opt for an unlimited plan, where you can recharge for 3000 tenges at the beginning of the month.

You can install the onay app or check the 'transport' section in Yandex to know about the estimated timings of the bus and plan your travel accordingly.

Note - Please do not forget to swipe your bus card or get a ticket during each ride. If caught, serious legal action may be taken against the person.

4. Student ID



Student ID officially symbolizes that you are a student of a specific university. It serves as a unique identifier and helps in tracking the academic progress of each student. It is necessary if you want to access any services throughout the university. For KazNU students, to obtain your student ID, dress appropriately and along with your passport go to the third floor of the Al-Farabi Library.

5. Taxi



Cab services like Yandex, Indriver, and Uber are readily available in the area. To use these services, simply download the corresponding app and enter your location. Taxis are a great alternative mode of transportation during the night when buses are not in service. Additionally, these apps offer an emergency

option, which allows you to notify the company of your location in case you feel unsafe during your ride.

6. Food



There are many great restaurants in Almaty that offer a wide variety of cuisines to suit the taste of international students. The commonly suggested dining restaurants by students are mentioned below-

Elephant, Lanzhou , Navat (expensive), Shafran
Asian - Deli, Spice Mantra, Tandoor, Uncle's cafe, Korean house, Manga,
Turkish- Degirmen, Esperanza, Ozyurt
Middle eastern- Tito Arcanum, Shukran Almaty, Tarih

Apart from restaurants, there are also chain restaurants which will be affordable for almost every student.

Example: Salam Bro, Zheka's Doner, Mr. Donerci, KFC, McDonald's, Ai Ai Ai Chicken, etc. These places can be perfect if you are looking for a quick and budget-friendly meal.

Cafe - Aroma, Coffee Room, Double coffee, Original Coffee, TeaDot, Pekarnya

7. Visa registration and renewal



When you come to Kazakhstan, you have approximately 48 hours to inform about your arrival at the office of visa and international recruitment. A delay in doing so can lead to a fine of 31,000 tenges.

Documents required-

Copy of

Passport Copy of Visa

Immigration stamp copy

Mention your full name, faculty, semester, course, current address, and local phone number behind the passport copy

For Visa renewal, you need to apply at least a month before your visa expiration date.

Documents required-

Copy of passport+visa

Mention your full name, faculty, semester, course, current address, local phone number, and order number (mentioned in your student profile in the Univer system) behind the passport copy.

Fill and submit the Visa renewal application (from the office of visa and international recruitment).
Payment for Visa renewal- 1,06,000 tenge

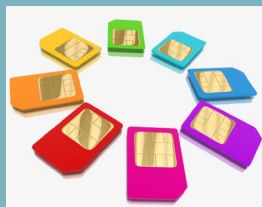
8. Cross Currency Exchange



You can exchange foreign currency in Kazakhstan at Currency Exchange bureaus, banks like Halyk, Center Credit, and some hotels. It is recommended to shop around for the best rate. At the time of the transaction, you will need to provide identification such as a passport.

Tip- Check with your bank or credit card company to see if they have any tie-ups or special exchange rates in Kazakhstan.

9. SIM card



Telecom providers Tele2, Beeline, and Kcell are the main options in the area. The cost of plans varies by provider. According to many international students, Tele2 offers the best coverage and a budget-friendly plan of around 14,000-16,000 tenge for a 6-month period. Another affordable option is Beeline's wifi and 3 sim card package, which can be obtained for around 9,000 tenges per month. Note that activating a SIM card requires your IIN.

It's not recommended to purchase SIM cards from the airport as they may be more expensive than the other option.

10. KASPI BANK

After getting your IIN number and a local phone number you can visit any Kaspi branch to open a bank account. There are more than 100 branches of this bank in Almaty.

(Address to the one nearest to KazNU is mentioned in the “LOCATIONS” section of the guidebook.)



The process is very smooth and takes about 20 minutes to complete. Documents required-

Passport

Hard copy of your IIN.

Visa

Government-approved ID of your country.

Example - Permanent Account Number (PAN) card for Indian students. Install “KASPI PAY” to make your transactions easier.

11. OPENING BANK ACCOUNT



You can only open a bank account, after receiving your IIN and a functioning local number.

Choose a bank and visit its nearest branch with the following documents-
IIN certificate (Original + Copy)

Notarised translation of your passport. Proof of address

Proof of your student status Complete the application process

Note - Requirements and process may vary depending on the bank you choose.

12. ACCOMMODATION



ON-CAMPUS

The university has 19 dorms out of which 15 are on campus. How to apply for a spot in one of these dorms?

Open “UNIVER”

Go to E-services Click on services

From the list of services, choose “Dormitory application”. Fill out the application form and submit it.

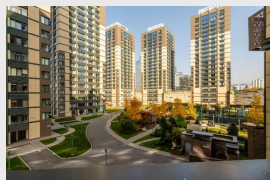

APARTMENTS



Apart from hostels, you can also opt for apartments. The lowest rental rates for apartments are found between October and April, particularly after the December holiday season. "Krisha.kz" is the most commonly used app for renting apartments, dorms, and rooms for students as you can check the prices, facilities, and photos of the chosen place on your phone. Usually, the cost varies between (170 - 320 USD) for 1 Bhk, and the prices go up depending on the space and facilities, including or excluding electricity bills.

**Beware of money frauds with the estate agents.*

13. SHOPPING MART



There are several shopping marts available to purchase daily necessities like groceries and home appliances. According to public opinion, Magnum is considered the best and most affordable option. You can use 2Gis to find the nearest location.

Other options include Small, Toimart, etc. (The address of the closest one to KazNU campus is provided in this guidebook). Additionally, there are also "magazines" around the country, which are small convenience stores that sell basic essentials.

14. FARMER'S MARKET

In addition to shopping marts, you can also find local markets like Zeleny Bazaar/Green Bazaar, Barakhodka, etc. where you can find a wide range of things such as fresh fruits, vegetables, dry fruits, imported food items, clothes, and locally-sourced products.



15. MALLS



Almaty has several malls that range from expensive to affordable on the budget spectrum. While Esentai mall and Dostyk plaza are quite expensive, Mega Park, Mega Alma-Ata, and Grand Park are more affordable. These malls offer a wide variety of shops, restaurants, and entertainment options for the public. You can find various shopping marts, pharmacies, food courts, and brand shops in these malls, such as Zara, Mango, and H&M.

16. WATER REFILL



It is not recommended for students to drink tap water. If your accommodation does not have a filter, then please find the nearest water refill center. You just need to take an empty bottle and refill it. 1L costs around 10-15 tenge. You can either pay in coins or by Kaspi. AQUAMAR, Akva.kz, Вода, Samal, Живая вода are a few stations where you can either fill your bottle or purchase new bottles of water.

There are water stations in almost a range of 500 meters around the main city area. You can find the nearest water station by searching the company names in the 2gis application. You can also just buy a small water purifier jug, which will cost around ~4000 tenges and can be used for 2 -3 months.

17. MEDICAL INSURANCE



It is MANDATORY for KazNU students to have medical insurance for the entire duration of their stay in Kazakhstan. We strongly advise you to get it in Almaty. Students can also seek to advice on medical insurance options in Kazakhstan. 18. FEES



If you have been admitted through a company, the fee process will be handled by them. If you do not have an agent, the fees can be paid via Kaspi, on a semester basis or for the entire year. The fees vary for different courses, so it's important to confirm with the university. Remember to keep a record of your transaction as the university will not provide any receipts.

19. STUDENT ORGANIZATIONS



Student organizations can provide a wide range of benefits to members, including opportunities for leadership, networking, and personal development. They can also serve as a way for students to connect with others who share similar interests and passions.

There are several student organizations in KazNU like ISA, Sunkar, Kaznu KMO, etc. However, ISA is the only organization which is exclusive to international students of different faculties and different universities across Kazakhstan.

20. INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS ASSOCIATION (ISA)

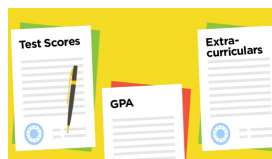

21. YEARLY GPA REQUIRED



Students must maintain a specific GPA depending on their faculty and the year of study. If their GPA falls below the required standard, they will be considered to have failed the year and will be required to retake it.

For example, the Faculty of “Medicine and Healthcare” requires students to maintain the below-mentioned GPA.

GPA FOR 1st YEAR:- 2.0

GPA FOR 2nd YEAR:- 2.1

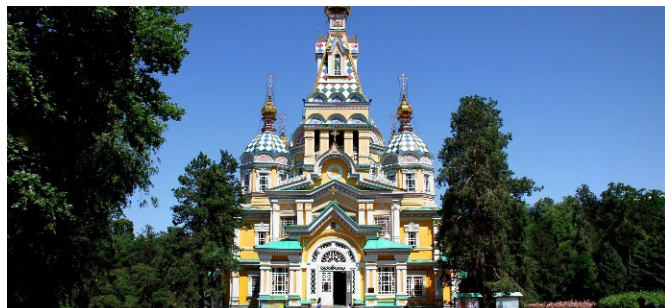
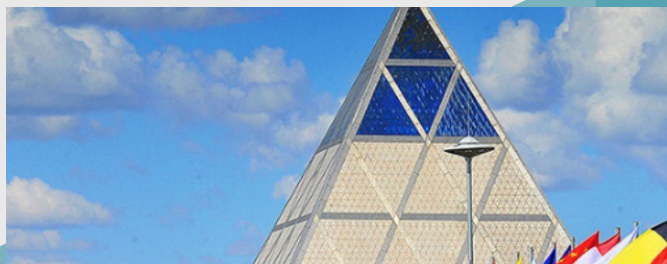
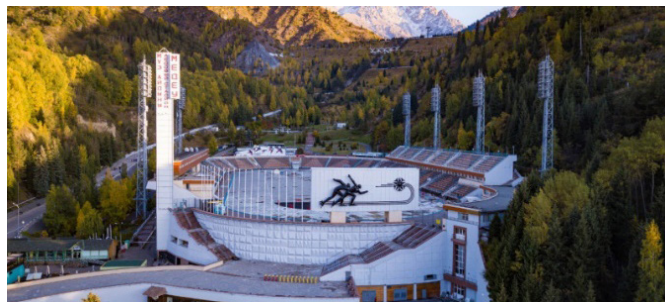
GPA FOR 3rd YEAR:- 2.2

Major tourist Attractions -

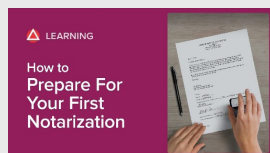
- Koktobe hill, Charyn canyon (best in summer), Huns ethno village, Arbat street, Alma- Arasan.

23. Notarization



Notarization is the process of certifying a document by a notary public and it can include getting documents apostilled or legalized, as well as translated. A notary public is a public official who is authorized by the government to witness the signing of important documents and to administer oaths. You can get it done anytime from your nearest notary office.

24. Nostrification



Holders of foreign certificates and diplomas who wish to receive their degree at KazNU must go through the process of nostrification, or recognition, during the first semester of their studies at the university. This procedure is necessary to ensure that their previous education and qualifications are recognized by the university and applicable to their program of study. It is important for international students to check the required procedures and documents they need to submit on the university website or with the university's academic office.
