Each new vocabulary and grammar is pumped from four sides: listening, reading, speaking and writing. Don't be afraid to make mistakes. Be confident in yourself. You can only learn from mistakes if you make them. Practice English every day. Create your own curriculum. Determine how many hours a week you can devote to learning the language, and stick to the plan. Do not try to understand every word — after reading the article to the end, you can go back to the beginning and find new words in the dictionary. To improve your writing style, brainstorm and write down all the ideas that come to mind, without worrying about grammar and spelling. Then think about the structure of the note.
