Type of study program: doctorate 1.2 Main indicators **The term of development -** 3 years of EP Form of study - day **Labor input -** 180 credits **Theoretical education:** 45 credits 1.3 Brief description The educational program of the specialty "8D042 - Customs affairs" was of the EP. developed in accordance with international standards of the WCO and the EU and is internationally accredited by the WCO. EP is implemented on the basis of the curriculum, which is formed according to the modular principle, based on the competence approach. The plan displays a logical sequence of mastering cycles of disciplines, as well as practices that ensure the formation of relevant competencies. The modules are grouped into blocks of basic and major disciplines, including university and elective components. The components are based on the professional standards of the World Customs Organization. The EP is aimed at the formation of doctoral students of general cultural and professional competencies necessary for successful activity and prepared for independent research, organizational and management activities. The following scientific areas of training in the specialty "8D042__ - Customs affairs" are provided 1. Problems of the organization of customs in the EAEU 2. Problems of customs tariff regulation 3. Problems of customs administration 4. Actual problems of combating customs offenses

2. Qualification requirements in the format of learning outcomes

2.1 Expected learning outcomes for EP (Based on the type (scope) of the future specialist's activities)

Upon completion of this program, students are expected to be able to:

- 1. Use methods of compiling and processing scientific and professional documentation in accordance with national and international standards, acquire modern information and bibliographic culture, skills in organizing scientific events using several working languages; evaluate quality, logically and consistently present research results; collect, process, analyze, systematize, synthesize information, prepare references and analytical reviews in customs.

Interpret and explain the theory of customs regulation, customs management and customs administration; conduct all types of training sessions, taking into account the requirements of methodological documentation using modern teaching technologies, student psychology and the latest achievements in pedagogical science; to develop methodological support for the educational process; negotiate and interact with the professional community and education stakeholders.

Apply new paradigms of customs and information technology management, forms and methods of information security; evaluate and formulate methodologies, technologies and tools for innovative management; organize work of structural units; to interact with management entities; maintain anticorruption policy; evaluate quality of the customs services, system of interaction between the customs services of the Republic of Kazakhstan and the EAEU member countries, organize liaison and cooperation between them.
- 5. Compare theory and practice of customs regulation; interpret and analyze the customs legislation of the Republic of Kazakhstan, the EAEU and the World Customs Organization; provide information and analytical support and apply information to customs regulation; carry out negotiations on customs regulation; shape state customs policy and measures for its implementation.

Identify trends and prospects for international cooperation and integration processes in the customs sphere; analyze the economic competitiveness of countries; forecast economic development and identify economic threats and risks; develop and control the process of formation of an optimal customs policy and legal support for the protection and promotion of national economic interests; ensure compliance with and enforcement of the customs legislation of the Republic of Kazakhstan, the EAEU, international treaties and agreements.

The educational program for the specialty "8D042__ - Customs 5. Description of the benefits and features of the EP in terms of affairs" complies with international professional standards adopted positioning in the educational by the WCO and the EU. According to the results of the rating of the IAAR and IQAAA, market the educational program "8D042 - Customs affairs" ranks first in Kazakhstan in 2017 and in 2018. To implement the educational program at the faculty there are the following laboratories and research centers: 1 Center for problems in the fight against crime 2 Research Center "Legal support of innovative development of Kazakhstan" 3 Center for Environmental Safety and Environmental Law 5 Scientific Consulting Legal Center "Nurly Zhol - Silk Road" Base practices:

- the system of central and local executive authorities at all levels,
- the system of central and local legislative bodies of all levels,
- national security agencies
- international organizations,
- non-governmental organizations and enterprises.

Staff potential. The faculty in the amount of 90 people focused on four departments. The faculty includes well-known scientists: 29 doctors of legal sciences, 50 candidates of legal sciences and 15 doctors of PhD. Among them, 16 winners of the grant "The best teacher of the university", 10 winners of the state scientific scholarship for talented young scientists, 8 winners of state awards. Teaching is also carried out by foreign professors and practitioners. Representatives of employers take an active part in the preparation of doctoral candidates: Parliament, Government, Ministry of Finance of the Republic of Kazakhstan, customs authorities.

The learning process is carried out in three languages, using the latest educational technologies. The best modern educational methods are used, among which are game trials, business games, trainings, as well as a combination of individual and team work.

Academic mobility. Every year, students in the specialty "8D042__ - Customs affairs" have the opportunity to go on scientific internships at leading universities in the world for three months. There are agreements on mutual cooperation in the

preparation of doctoral students with universities of the Russian Federation, China, South Korea, USA, France, Germany, Great Britain, Poland, Finland, Latvia, and Lithuania. Scientific advisors of doctoral students are leading scientists of the Republic of Kazakhstan and foreign countries.

Doctoral students are actively involved in the implementation of research, funded by the Ministry of Education and Science of the Republic of Kazakhstan, funded from other sources, in the organization of scientific conferences and theoretical seminars, the preparation and publication of monographs, scientific articles and reports. During the preparation of dissertation research doctoral students go abroad to work in scientific libraries of leading foreign research centers and universities.

Comparison with similar programs of foreign universities. The educational program in the specialty "8D042__ - Customs affairs" corresponds to world standards. Focuses on similar programs of foreign universities in England, USA, Europe and Asia.

6. Requirements for applicants

Professional education - doctoral studies are carried out on the basis of higher postgraduate (master) education. Admission to the doctoral program is carried out on a competitive basis on the basis of the results of the entrance exams in accordance with the "Model rules for admission to universities".

The conditions of competitive selection correspond to the "Model rules for admission to the doctoral program of universities of the Republic of Kazakhstan"
