## MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN AL-FARABI KAZAKH NATIONAL UNIVERSITY WASEDA UNIVERSITY

- 1. Al-Farabi Kazakh National University and Waseda University hereby agree to encourage academic cooperation through research and study in furtherance of the advancement of learning as stipulated below:
  - To encourage visits by faculty from one university to the other for the purpose of (1)engaging in research or other educational activities;
  - (2)To facilitate the admission of qualified students from one university to the other for the purpose of enrolling in undergraduate and graduate programmes, and in the case of advanced graduate students, participating in research;
  - To foster the exchange of academic publications and scholarly information; and (3)
  - To promote other academic activities which enhance the above mentioned goals. (4)

Both universities acknowledge that the visit by faculty and students from one university to the other shall be subject to the entry and visa regulations of Kazakhstan and Japan, and shall comply with the regulations and policies of Al-Farabi Kazakh National University and Waseda University.

- 2. Both universities agree that all expenses, including research material, international and domestic travel, per diem, honoraria and all other costs, shall be the responsibility of the home university or visiting faculty and students themselves unless otherwise stated. However, each side will do its utmost to make available university accommodation to visiting faculty and students.
- 3. Both universities agree to review this Memorandum of Understanding after five years following the date of signing. It shall be automatically renewed for successive five-year periods unless either party gives the other written notice of its desire to either terminate or revise this Memorandum twelve months prior to the termination of a given five-year period.
