



**AGREEMENT
ON ACADEMIC EXCHANGE AND COOPERATION BETWEEN
PHYSICO-TECHNICAL FACULTY,
AL-FARABI KAZAKH NATIONAL UNIVERSITY
(REPUBLIC OF KAZAKHSTAN)
AND
GRADUATE SCHOOL OF SCIENCE /SCHOOL OF SCIENCE,
OSAKA UNIVERSITY
(JAPAN)**

The Physico-Technical Faculty, al-Farabi Kazakh National University, the Republic of Kazakhstan, by the Dean, Professor Dosktor Asikov, on the one part,

and
the Graduate School of Science/the School of Science, Osaka University, Japan, by the Dean, Professor Atsushi Shimbara, on the other part, (both hereinafter referred to as the Parties collectively, or Party individually).

taking into consideration good and strong international relations between the Republic of Kazakhstan and Japan,

recognizing the necessity and the possibility for developing further perspective bilateral relations between two countries in educational and scientific fields of cooperation,

wishing to make their own contribution to development of cooperation between two institutions in the aforementioned fields,

hereby conclude the Agreement on scientific and academic exchange and cooperation with following provisions:

Article 1

Based on the principle of mutual benefit and respect for each other's independence, the Parties will foster:

- a) Faculty and administrative staff exchange;
- b) Student exchange at graduate level and undergraduate level;
- c) Joint research activities;
- d) Organization of scientific and academic meetings and symposiums;
- e) Exchange of academic information, publications, materials and knowledge;
- f) Other activities as may be mutually agreed by the two Parties.

In order to give effect to these forms of cooperation, representatives of individual faculties and institutes within the two institutions will be encouraged to consult each other and to develop specific plans for collaboration in any or all of the ways mentioned above.

Article 2

The implementation of each program based upon this Agreement shall be negotiated and agreed upon by the Parties under a separate agreement prior to the initiation of the particular program. This separate agreement will clearly describe the functions and activities to be developed, work schedule, personal profile, financing, rights and obligations of each Party, as well as the required documents necessary to determine the goals and scope of each program.

Article 3

It is understood, that each and every activity undertaken under this Agreement is approved by the appropriate officials at each institution and falls within each institution's academic and fiscal constraints. The results of the cooperative researches including but not limited to any newly produced intellectual rights shall be operated currently and fairly through due consultation between the Parties.

Article 4

In the process of implementation of the Agreement's provisions the two institutions shall act according to the legislation of their home countries.

All cooperative activities in article 1 above shall be done in compliance with all applicable laws, regulations and guidelines of the country and institutions in which the activity is conducted.

Article 5

This Agreement shall come into effect upon signature of this document by authorized representatives of both institutions and shall remain in force for a period of three years or until terminated by either institution by notification. The notification for termination of this Agreement shall be made not later than six months prior to the termination date. Regardless of termination, the Parties shall continue to fulfill their obligations hereunder until all participants who have commenced the program have completed the term in session at the time of termination. This Agreement may be modified at any time after due consultation between the Parties. In the absence of any such early termination, the renewal of this agreement shall be discussed by the two parties no less than 6 months prior to the stated termination of the current agreement.

Article 6

The Agreement is created in English. Two copies of this Agreement shall be made, one to be held by each institution, and both shall serve as original.
