Zarema graduated from the math class in 1970 to enter Kazakh State University which she has graduated *cum laudae* in 1975. Since then she served for our university as research associate, then senior research associate of the Department of Darwin Studies and Genetics. Then she has deepened her knowledge as a post-graduate of the Institute of Cytology and Genetics of Siberian Branch of USSR Acad. Sci. in Novosibirsk to have her Ph.D. thesis in Genetics defended in 1994. After returning to home university in Almaty she joined as Associate Professor the Department of Ecology and Soil Sciences.

Zarema is author of more than 80 proceedings including 10 textbooks. In her most recent projects she has dealt with oil contamination and the assessment of its impact on biota and the state of human health as well as consequences of irradiational and chemical contaminations of the mines. She devotedly reads such courses as General Ecology, Global Ecology, Ecology and Sustainable Development, Industrial Ecology, Applied Biology, Population Ecology, Human Ecology and Concepts of Modern Natural History.
