- Charge no fees to incoming students for tuition, registration, examinations or access
  to laboratory and library facilities. Nevertheless, they may be charged small fees on
  the same basis as local students for costs such as insurance, student unions and the
  use of miscellaneous material.

#### G. Validity and termination of the agreement

This Agreement is valid for 5 (five) years from the day it was signed by both institutions. This Agreement might be terminated at any time by either party by giving written notification to the other party of at least one calendar year. This means that a unilateral decision to discontinue the exchanges notified to the other party by e.g. 1 November 2019 will only take effect as of 1 November 2020; otherwise the Agreement will be automatically considered to be prolonged for one more year.

#### **H. Final provisions**

Any differences arising out of the interpretation and/or the implementation of this Agreement shall be resolved amicably through consultation and/or negotiation by the parties.
